IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. When upon a public place the animal is to be under the control of a competent person, and it is preferred that at such be retained by a leash, cord, chain or similar device.
2. It is advisable that the animal wears its current identification tag issued by the Coomalie Community Government Council as for example this will assist in its return if it is lost.
3. If the owner of the dog has not reached the age of 18 then a parent or guardian must sign this form as a joint owner.
4. A person who registers the animal on behalf of its owner is required to show that authority in writing. This is to be attached to the application.
5. If you wish to keep more than two (2) dogs at a property within a Coomalie township, you must apply for an Additional Dog Licence. Approval must be obtained before keeping more than two dogs.
