Your attention is drawn to the following important points:

- You must sign your child in and out of the session each day, recording who is intending to collect your child that day also.
- Children are under the Community Recreation Officer's authority for the duration of the excursion. A child may be returned home at the expense of the parent/caregiver if the supervisor considers that circumstances warrant such action.
- As the program is not a childcare service, we do not allow children under the age of 6 to attend unless accompanied by a guardian over the age of 18. With a minimum age of 5 years.
- The Coomalie Community Government Council has a duty of care for children engaged in council related activities, including excursions and sporting events under its direction or supervision. All reasonable steps will be taken to protect students against foreseeable risks of injury or harm.
- Financial responsibility for medical and other costs incurred in emergency situations or where a decision is taken to return a child home, rests with the parent/guardian of the child. Parents may wish to take out additional insurance to cover such costs.
- Liability for loss, theft or damage to child's property is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the child.
- Due to Contact Tracing requirements, child details will be held by Council and handed to the Chief Health Officer or their representative on request.
