Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, people of all ages gathered here at St. Jerome's for All Souls' Day, we come with hearts that carry both joy and sorrow. We remember those who have gone before us, and we trust that Christ, who conquered death, also meets us in our grief today. Whether you are young or old, whether your calendar is full of plans or quiet moments, the invitation remains: to open our minds and souls to the mercy of God, who turns mourning into song.

In the gospel reading of today, Jesus enters a moment of deep sorrow. A widow has just lost her only son; a family is broken; an entire town might feel its future dim. Into that scene of lament, Jesus moves with compassion. He sees, he names the pain, and he acts to restore life.

For All Souls' Day, we stand before the mystery of death and the promise of resurrection. We do not pretend that grief is easy or that tears are unnecessary. Rather, we acknowledge that grief is real, and in God's mercy, grief can become a doorway to faith, memory, and hope.

Jesus' compassion: "Don't cry" Verse 13 of the Gospel records Jesus saying, "Don't cry." It may seem a strange thing to say in such a moment. But notice what Jesus does next: he touches the bier, speaks to the young man, and restores him to life. In the healthy and holy economy of God, sorrow is not denied; it is met with tender mercy that reclaims life from the brink.

Young people of St Jerome's Parish, you may carry fears about the future; you might wonder how to live well in a world of change. My Older friends, you carry memories that sometimes ache with longing. All of us carry the ache of missing someone we love. Jesus speaks a word of comfort into that ache: you are not alone. He sees your tears, and he moves toward you with compassion.


On All Souls' Day, we remember that death is not the final word. We proclaim that Christ's resurrection defeats death's sting and opens a future full of grace. Our prayers for the departed are not only petitions for peace; they are acts of faith that trust in the living Lord who holds the last page of our story.

A practical path for today

1) Sit with your grief, and name it to God. Offer your tears as a prayer, not a burden you must carry alone. May the Lord of life fill the hearts of all here—young and old—with the hope that endures. May we be strengthened to support one another in suffering, to celebrate life when it returns, and to lay hold of the promise that in Christ, all things are being made new.

And now, as we remember those who have died in the peace of Christ, may we go with the blessing of God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Amen. God bless Fr. Hygi.




