Pastor's Desk

Beloved brothers and sisters in Christ,

"Arise! Shine, for your light has come, the glory of the Lord has dawned upon you" (Isaiah 60:1). With these powerful words, the prophet Isaiah sets the tone for today's feast. The Epiphany is the celebration of God's light made visible—not hidden, not reserved for a few, but revealed to the whole world.

In the Gospel, that light appears as a star, guiding the Magi from distant lands. These were not members of the chosen people; they were foreigners, seekers, outsiders. Yet they were attentive to the signs of God at work in the world. They followed the light they were given, even when the journey was long and uncertain. Their arrival at Bethlehem tells us something essential about God: God desires to be found by all who sincerely seek Him.

Isaiah's vision comes alive in this moment: nations streaming toward Jerusalem, bearing gifts of gold and frankincense, rejoicing in the radiance of God's glory. What the prophet proclaimed centuries earlier is fulfilled in the humble house in Bethlehem. The Epiphany reminds us that God's glory is not confined to palaces or centers of power, but revealed in humility, vulnerability, and love.

Saint Paul, in the Letter to the Ephesians, names this mystery clearly: the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and partners in the promise in Christ Jesus. The Epiphany is not just about the Magi long ago; it is about us —people of every nation, culture, and background—being drawn into God's saving plan. At St. Jerome's Parish here in Norwalk, with our rich diversity of peoples and stories, this truth is lived and celebrated each time we gather around the same altar.

Yet the Gospel also places before us a contrast. While the Magi are willing to travel far, risk much, and offer their best, Herod is troubled, and the religious leaders remain unmoved. Proximity to Scripture and tradition does not automatically lead to conversion. The Epiphany challenges us to ask: Are we willing to be changed by the Christ we claim to seek? Like the Magi, will we allow an encounter with Jesus to send us home by "another way"?

Finally, the gifts offered—gold, frankincense, and myrrh—are not only symbols of who Jesus is: King, God, and Savior who will suffer. They also reflect what we are invited to bring: our resources, our prayer, our struggles, our very lives. When we place these before the Lord, His light shines not only upon us but through us.
