# Pastor's Desk

#### Introduction:

Today's readings invite us to reflect on the themes of hospitality, listening, and the importance of cultivating a heart open to God's presence and to those around us. Both stories emphasize the significance of welcoming others—not just as a duty, but as an encounter with God Himself.

#### Genesis 18:1–10a — Abraham's Hospitality:

In this passage, Abraham receives three visitors, whom he recognizes as messengers of God. His immediate response is one of generous hospitality: rushing to serve them, offering water, food, and rest. Abraham's hospitality is not merely courteous; it is a profound act of faith and openness to God's presence.

#### **Key points:**

Abraham's hospitality exemplifies reverence and readiness to serve God through service to others. His willingness to welcome strangers reflects the openness necessary to encounter God. The promise of Isaac symbolizes hope and God's providence, rooted in Abraham's trust and hospitality.

#### Luke 10:38–42 — Martha and Mary:

In the Gospel, Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary. Martha is busy with the many preparations, while Mary sits at Jesus' feet, listening to His words. Martha's concern for hospitality leads her to frustration when Mary chooses to listen instead.

#### Key points:

Martha's busyness highlights the importance of service, but also the danger of missing the essential: listening to lesus.

Mary's choice to sit and listen signifies the importance of contemplative prayer and attentiveness to God's word. Jesus gently reminds Martha that "one thing is necessary," emphasizing that our relationship with Jesus should be our priority.

#### Connecting the Readings:

Both stories teach us that true hospitality and service involve more than external acts; they require opening our hearts to God's presence. Abraham's welcoming of visitors prefigures our openness to divine encounters, while Martha and Mary show us the balance between active service and contemplative listening.

#### **Practical Application:**

Are we like Abraham, eager to welcome others and serve as an expression of our faith? Are we like Martha, busy with duties but forgetting the importance of listening to Jesus? Do we carve out time to sit at Jesus' feet, to listen and reflect on His Word? How can we create space in our lives for both active service and contemplative prayer?

#### Conclusion:

This Sunday, let us be inspired by Abraham's hospitality and Mary's attentiveness. May we learn to open our homes and hearts to others, welcoming Christ in all we do, and prioritizing listening to His voice amidst our busy lives. In doing so, we encounter Christ Himself and grow in faith, hope, and love.

July Food Drive July 18th to July 27th for the Fairfield AIDS Project organization which provides Housing, Hope and Health assistance to people who need to relearn skills to live independently whether it be from substance abuse, mental illness, homelessness and HIV prevention.

MFAP recently was able to purchase two buildings at 7 Moore Place in Norwalk, with plans to remodel and turn them into group homes. These buildings will be an addition to the group home they have been running for 10 years at 9 Moore Place. They also have a Food Pantry at the office on West Avenue to provide those in need with food items.

Most needed items: Breakfast Cereals, Tuna fish, Canned or Packs of Peaches, Canned Soups, Peanut Butter and Strawberry Jelly, Dried or Can Beans, Spaghetti & Ziti (pasta) and Tomato Sauce.


