Pastor's Desk

Homily for the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C) Theme: Persistent Prayer and God's Mercy

Reading References:

Genesis 18:20–32: Abraham's intercession for Sodom and Luke 11:1–13: Jesus teaching about prayer & God's generosity.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today, we reflect on two powerful passages that highlight the importance of prayer, persistence, and God's mercy. In Genesis, we see Abraham boldly interceding for the wicked cities, negotiating with God for mercy. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus teaches us how to pray confidently, emphasizing that our Heavenly Father is generous and eager to bless us.

As St. Jerome, renowned for his dedication to Scripture and prayer, would remind us, God's Word invites us into a deeper relationship—one rooted in honest dialogue and unwavering trust.

1. Abraham's Boldness in Prayer (Genesis 18:20–32): In the Genesis account, Abraham approaches God with humility but also with boldness. He dares to question, to negotiate, to plead for mercy for Sodom. His persistent intercession shows us that prayer is not just about asking once but about perseverance. Abraham's dialogue with God reveals his deep concern for righteousness and justice. What can we learn? Prayer requires boldness and honesty.

We should not hesitate to bring our concerns and the needs of others before God. Persistent prayer can influence God's decisions and open the door for mercy.

2. Jesus' Teaching on Prayer (Luke 11:1–13): In the Gospel, Jesus models prayer with the Lord's Prayer and then encourages us with the parable of the friend at midnight. He emphasizes persistence: "Ask, seek, knock." It reveals that God, unlike the reluctant friend, is eager to answer our prayers. What can we learn? Prayer is about relationship; we approach God as our loving Father.

Persistence in prayer demonstrates our trust and dependence on God. God's generosity surpasses human understanding; He gives good gifts to His children.

- 3. Connecting the Dots: Both passages challenge us to be persistent and honest in prayer. Abraham's negotiation with God teaches us that prayer can influence divine decisions, while Jesus assures us of God's eagerness to give good things. In the spirit of St. Jerome: Let us deepen our understanding of Scripture, embracing prayer as a dialogue with our merciful Father. Like Abraham, let us approach God with humility but also with confidence, trusting that He hears us and will answer according to His divine wisdom.
- 4. Practical Application: Be persistent in prayer: Don't give up when answers seem delayed. Trust that God's timing is perfect.

Pray for mercy and justice: Intercede for our communities, nation, and the world.

Deepen our understanding of Scripture: As Jerome emphasized, Scripture is a wellspring of wisdom needed for our spiritual growth.

Conclusion: As we go forth this week, may we emulate Abraham's boldness and Jesus' encouragement to ask, seek, and knock. Let us approach God with confidence, knowing that He is a generous Father who desires to bless us and our world.

Remember: Our prayers are powerful, especially when rooted in faith and persistence. Let us pray always with trust, humility, and hope.

May God bless us all. Amen. God bless Fr. Hygi.


