# Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel from Luke presents us with a powerful calling and a profound reminder of our mission as followers of Jesus. Jesus, in His great compassion, sends out His seventy-two disciples to go ahead of Him, two by two, into the towns and places He Himself intended to visit. He gives them instructions, warnings, and encouragement. "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few," Jesus says. He urges us to pray for more workers, and then He sends His disciples out with a mission: to heal the sick, proclaim peace, and announce that the Kingdom of God is near. When they return, joy fills their hearts as they witness the power vested in them through Jesus' name.

What does this mean for us today?

First, it reminds us that we are called to be active participants in God's mission. Just as those early disciples were sent out to bring the Good News, we are also called to be witnesses of Christ's love in our everyday lives—through our work, our families, our communities, and even in small acts of kindness.

Second, Jesus emphasizes reliance on God rather than on ourselves. When He tells the disciples to carry no luggage, no extra shoes, and to rely on the hospitality of others, He's urging us to trust fully in God's provision. Our strength and courage come from Him, not from our own resources.

Third, Jesus' instructions about shaking the dust off your feet when facing rejection serve as a reminder that we are called to persevere in our mission, even when it's difficult. Sometimes, our efforts will be met with indifference or opposition, but we must remember that the ultimate success belongs to God. Our role is to be faithful and obedient. Finally, the joy of the disciples' return—"Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name"—highlights the spiritual authority and victory we share through Jesus. Yet, Jesus gently reminds them—and us—that rejoice not in mere power or success, but in our relationship with God and our salvation. True joy comes from knowing we belong to Him and share in His victory over sin and death.

What is the takeaway for us today?

As members of St. Jerome's Parish, we are called to be active, faithful, and joyful witnesses of Christ. Each of us has a role in the harvest—whether through prayer, service, or proclamation. We are sent out like those early disciples, not alone but empowered by the Holy Spirit. Let us pray for more workers to join in this mission. Let us trust in God's provision and persevere in the face of challenges. And let us find our greatest joy in being part of God's divine plan—knowing that through us, His love and salvation reach others. May the Holy Spirit strengthen us for this mission, and may we always rejoice in the Lord's victory.
