Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's readings invite us to place our trust completely in God, especially when faith becomes difficult. In the first reading, the prophet Jeremiah experiences rejection, ridicule, and persecution because he remains faithful to God's message. Yet he does not give up; he entrusts himself to the Lord who is always at his side.

In the Gospel, Jesus repeats a powerful command three times: "Do not be afraid." He knows that His disciples will face opposition and challenges. But He reminds them that they are precious in God's eyes: "Even all the hairs of your head are counted." God's care for us is personal, constant, and loving.

St. Paul, in the second reading, teaches that while sin entered the world through one man, Adam, salvation and grace come through Jesus Christ. No matter how great our weaknesses may be, God's grace is greater.

For us at St. Jerome Parish, the message is clear: do not let fear prevent you from living your faith. In our families, workplaces, schools, and community, we are called to witness to Christ with courage and confidence. The Lord who knows us so intimately will never abandon us.

May this Eucharist strengthen us to trust in God's providence, overcome our fears, and boldly proclaim our faith in Jesus Christ.
