Pastor's Desk

Beloved parishioners of St. Jerome Church,

On this Trinity Sunday, the Gospel of St. John gives us one of the most beloved verses in all of Scripture: “For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son...” (John 3:16–18). In these few words, we encounter the mystery of the Holy Trinity — a God who is not distant, but a communion of perfect love.

The Father loves the world. The Son is given for the salvation of the world. The Holy Spirit opens our hearts to believe and to live in that love. The Trinity is not simply a doctrine to understand; it is the very life of God into which we are invited.

Jesus reminds us that he came not to condemn the world, but to save it. In a time when many people carry burdens, fears, and divisions, the Church is called to reflect the love of the Trinity — a love that forgives, unites, and gives life.

Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim that we belong to the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. May we also live in a way that shows others the hope and mercy of God.
