The compassionate staff at Aboriginal Funerals provide individual funeral services designed to meet the needs of each person with cultural sensitivity and awareness.

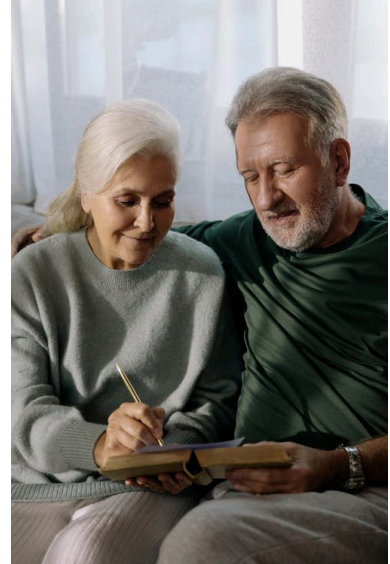

Initial Consultation

Choose from a range of service options, including burial or cremation, traditional or contemporary ceremonies, and specific cultural or religious elements. Dailey Funerals will then finalise arrangements by coordinating all details, such as venue booking, transportation, floral arrangements, and necessary legal paperwork, to ensure a seamless process.

Aftercare and Follow-Up

01. What Do Funeral Directors Do?

Funeral directors handle both administrative and caregiving responsibilities. Administratively, they arrange body transportation, complete paperwork, and execute the family's funeral choices. As caregivers, they provide support and advice, help the bereaved cope with loss, and offer resources and referrals for grief support and professional help. They also connect survivors with support groups and community resources.

02. How does Dailey Funerals accommodate various cultural and religious practices?

Dailey Funerals respects and integrates diverse cultural and religious practices into their services. They accommodate among others Aboriginal, Hindu, Catholic, Orthodox Christian, and Islamic traditions by working closely with families to honor specific rites and customs. This includes arranging traditional ceremonies, coordinating with religious leaders, and ensuring that all cultural and religious aspects are respectfully observed throughout the funeral process.

03. Why should we have a viewing?

Viewing the deceased can serve various purposes and is integral to numerous cultural and ethnic traditions. Many grief specialists advocate for this practice, as it can help the bereaved confront and accept the reality of death. In some cases, children may also be encouraged to view the deceased, provided they wish to do so and the process is carefully explained to them.

04. Are there any government subsidies or financial assistance for funerals in NSW?

Yes, the NSW Government provides a Funeral Assistance program for eligible low-income individuals. Additionally, Centrelink offers a Bereavement Payment to help with funeral expenses. Check with your local Centrelink office for eligibility and application details.

05. How long does a funeral arrangement meeting take?

We ask that you allow 1 - 2 hours to meet with your funeral arranger. This will give you the necessary time to cover the essential details and plan a personalised funeral service that honours the life of your loved one
