

ORDER FOR ELECTION TO BE HELD MAY 2, 2026 FOR TWO (2) COMMISSIONER POSITIONS ON THE BOARD OF EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMISSIONERS OF HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80 AS PROVIDED UNDER HEALTH & SAFETY CODE, SECTION 775.0345

WHEREAS, HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80 (the "District") operates pursuant to Texas Constitution, Article III, Section 48-e, and Chapter 775, Texas Health & Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, the District is a Harris County District and is therefore governed by an elected Board of Emergency Services Commissioners under Chapter 775, Texas Health & Safety Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §775.0345, Health & Safety Code, the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners serve alternating four-year terms;

WHEREAS, in this year of the District operations, pursuant to Section 775.0345, Texas Health & Safety Code, two (2) Commissioner positions are ending their regular terms; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners finds that it is necessary to call for an election for two (2) positions on the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Section 775.0345, Texas Health & Safety Code, requires that such Election be held in conformity with Section 41.001, of the Texas Election Code, providing for Uniform Election Dates,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an Election be held in HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80 on Saturday, May 2, 2026, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., to elect two (2) persons to serve as Commissioners of HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80 for the four-year terms commencing after the results have been canvassed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. (a) The ballot for the Election shall provide for voting for none, one, or two among those candidates listed or written in by the voter (as may be allowed by law).

(b) The two (2) candidates receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected in accordance with law. Election shall be by plurality vote.

(c) In the event of a tie vote among all the candidates or among those candidates each having the second or third most votes, the resolution of the tie shall be resolved in accordance with Section 2.002, Texas Election Code.

2. The Election shall be held within one (1) District Election Precinct and at the Polling Places designated by Order of the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners, subject to any changes as may be made under the authority of such Order:

3. Only persons qualified to vote within the geographic boundaries of **HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80** shall be allowed to vote at the Election and each voter shall vote at the Polling Place designated by Order of the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners.

4. The voting in the District's Election Precincts shall utilize the Verity Voting System (Hart version 2.7) as certified by the Texas Secretary of State on August 24, 2023. The candidates' names shall appear on the voting machine in the form as required by law and in such a manner that each voter may cast no vote or may cast one vote for each of none, one, two, or three candidates among those candidates listed or written in by the voter.

5. All candidates must file an application in accordance with the Texas Election Code (including Chapter 141, Subchapters A and B, and Chapter 144, Texas Election Code). All candidates are obligated to determine on their own whether their application is correct in form and content.

6. All applications for a place on the ballot must be filed with Randy Foster, District Secretary, or his Appointed Agent, and must be received by mail or in person to 123 S. Diamondhead Blvd., Crosby, Texas 77532, not prior to January 14, 2026 and not later than 5:00 p.m. on February 13, 2026. The procedures and time requirements for write-in candidacies are governed by Subchapter C, Chapter 146, Election Code.

7. The order of the candidates' names shall be determined by a drawing held in accordance with and under the time parameters set forth in §52.094, Texas Election Code. As required by law, candidates' names may only appear as an independent, without denoting any political or party affiliation.

8. Stacey Ponder is hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerk for the Election. Early voting shall be conducted from April 20, 2026 (the date which represents the earliest date on which early voting may begin) through April 28, 2026 (the date which represents the last day on which early voting may be performed). As ordered by the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners, the location of main early voting place is designated as follows:

123 S. Diamondhead Blvd.

Crosby, Texas 77532
Monday-Friday: 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Except as otherwise provided below, there shall be no early voting on any Saturday or Sunday or on any official national or state holiday.

9. For the use of those voters in the District who are entitled by law to vote early by mail, the Early Voting Clerk above named shall receive applications for early voting ballots to be voted by mail in accordance with the Texas Election Code. For the use of those voters who are entitled by law to vote an early voting ballot by mail, the District shall provide each voter with a paper ballot and instructions to make a mark on the paper ballot.

10. Ballot by mail applications and ballots voted shall be sent to the Early Voting Clerk at **123 S. Diamondhead Blvd., Crosby, Texas 77532**. There shall be no provision for telephonic facsimile transmission of ballot applications. The applications for ballot by mail must be received by **April 20, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.**

11. The following concurrent and subsequent Orders, among other Orders, may be made by the District to facilitate the Election: Order Approving and Appointing an Agent; Order Establishing and Designating Election Precincts and Polling Places; Order Appointing Presiding Election Judges and Alternating Presiding Judges; Order Appointing Early Voting Ballot Board; Order Appointing Early Voting Clerks.

12. In accordance with all applicable Federal and State law, there shall be provided Spanish, Vietnamese and Mandarin (Traditional) translations of the ballot as well as other election materials.

13. This Order constitutes the Election Order of HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80 Election to elect two (2) persons to serve as Commissioners of HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 80 for four-year terms commencing after the results have been canvassed. The Notice of the Election shall be prepared in accordance with law and shall be given by publication. Such publication shall be made one time in a daily newspaper of general circulation within the geographic boundaries of the District, said publication to be made not earlier than the 30th day nor later than the 10th day before the Election Date. Further, a copy of such Notice shall, not later than the 21st day before the Election Date, be posted on the bulletin board or other place conspicuous to the public used for posting Notices of the meetings of the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners and a copy shall be filed with the County Clerk of Harris County, Texas. After publication, the District Board of Emergency Services Commissioners shall retain a copy of the published Notice that contains the name of the newspaper in which it was published and the date of publication.
