Dress Code: All exhibitors must wear black pants, white shirt, white lab coat and closed-toe boots/dress shoes. Age: Exhibitor must be 5 years old as of January 1st of the current year.

Rules:

- 1. Please be sure your birds are healthy, clean, and vermin-free before checking in. Any bird determined to have lice or mites or to show symptoms of disease will be required to leave the barn immediately. Condition bird must be clean, healthy, have good feather quality and be prepared for show.
- 2. Two entries per class per exhibitor. Maximum of fifteen (15) birds per exhibitor.
- 3. All meat birds must be the same sex and size. All market POULTRY will be ordered by the superintendent and will be 10 weeks of age and a minimum of 6lbs. Market turkeys must weigh a minimum of 16 lbs. Market ducks are to be 8-10 weeks of age.
- 4. Entry deadline is JULY 15th. ALL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JULY 15th. PEN FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. Absolutely NO ENTRIES will be accepted after JULY 15th, 2025.
- 5. Mandatory Tagging/Banding date will be at Fair check-in at the Poultry Barn. All market birds must be brought to Fairgrounds to be tagged on this date before the fair starts.
- 6. Chickens, geese, ducks, turkeys: Due at Fair on Saturday, August 2, 2025, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- 7. Pens will be assigned as poultry is checked in by the Superintendents.
- 8. For all poultry, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have proof of a negative Pullorum Test. Testing is available at Wayne County Fairgrounds when checking in at Fair.
- 9. The Superintendent, for identification, will band all meat birds and waterfowl.
- 10. Exhibitors are to provide their own shavings, feed, and dishes (dishes need to be of suitable size).
- 11. All Exhibitors are responsible for doing Barn Duty.
- 12. Waterfowl must stay in pens.
- 13. All pens must be cleaned by 10:00 a.m. every day except Tuesday. Tuesday is show day and pens must be cleaned prior to the show.
- 14. Accumulation of three (3) demerits for unkempt birds, cages, feed and water dishes, and no Barn Duty will result in forfeiture of premiums.
- 15. Animals will not be released from their pens until August 10, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums. Market animals may leave with the processor after 11:00 p.m. on Saturday of Fair week. Auction animals may be taken to a livestock sale barn after 11:00 p.m. on Saturday of Fair week.
- 16. All barn decorations must remain up until after 11:00 p.m. on August 9, 2025. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums.
- 17. An exhibitor's animals must be entered in breed or meat class in addition to Showmanship. Exhibitors are required to show their own animals.
- 18. All youth must attach their dishes to the cages.
