Dress Code: All exhibitors will wear shirts with collar and sleeves, denim pants, and hard-soled shoes or boots. No clothes with holes and/or are thread bare.

Age: Exhibitor must be 5 years old as of January 1st of the current year.

* Exhibitors 5 and 6 years old must have an experienced Shepherd or Parent assisting the youth. The exhibitor may also use a halter.

Rules:

- See General Rules for Dairy, Livestock Divisions and Exhibitor Dress Code. 1.
- In addition to the conformation class, exhibitors must enter and compete in the Showmanship class. 2.
- An exhibitor may not show more than one animal per class, except where progeny necessitates duplication. 3. Premiums paid on only one animal, if duplicate entries in a class.
- 4. One individual from pen of two may be entered in the individual market class.
- 5. Exhibitors must maintain clean pens and animals throughout the Fair or exhibits will be sent home.
- 6. All livestock animals must be on the fairgrounds on Sunday August 3, 2025, by 2:00 p.m.
- 7. Fitting and Showmanship classes: Animal must be washed when arriving for check-in. Fitting and blocking may be done at Fairgrounds.
- 8. Entry deadline is JULY 15th. ALL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JULY 15th. STALL FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. Absolutely NO ENTRIES will be accepted after JULY 15th, 2025!
- 9. Grand & Reserve Champion market animals must be sold at auction.
- 10. Market animals must be weighed on arrival at Fairgrounds. Classes will be divided into lightweight, middleweight, and heavyweight. Weight divisions will be determined after weighing in. Consideration will be given to class size.
- 11. All market lambs must be in possession and tagged according to livestock rules. Ear notches or color markings must correspond to the registration papers.
- 12. NO rams allowed.
- 13. Market lambs must meet the minimum weight requirement of 86 lbs. to be exhibited at the Wayne County Fair.
- 14.. All livestock shows will be "NATURAL SHOW" which is defined as not using any products on the animal for fitting and showing. Clipping, sheering, and trimming of livestock animals will still be allowed. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in disqualification and loss of premiums.
- 15. All Grand and Reserve Grand lambs must go through youth auction.
- 16. Animals will not be released from their stalls until August 10, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums. Market animals may leave with the processor after 11:00 p.m. on Saturday of Fair week. Auction animals may be taken to a livestock sale barn after 11:00 p.m. on Saturday of Fair week.
- 17. All stalls must be cleaned by the youth and inspected by the barn superintendent upon final departure. Failure to clean stalls and have them inspected will result in the loss of all premiums.
- 18. All barn decorations may be removed after 11:00 p.m. on August 9, 2025, Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums.
- 19. All sheep information placing sheets will be turned into the barn superintendent by 4:00 p.m. on Sunday of shipin or sheep barn superintendent will place sheep in the classes as she/he sees fit. All animals must be shown by the person who is identified on the sheet.
