I would like to thank everyone who participated in our Mass Time Change Survey. Your participation was invaluable in helping me with our Parish Leadership Team and Pastoral Council make the most informed decision for the good of our parish moving forward.

I would like to revisit the primary goals of making the changes to the times which the Sacrifice of the Mass is offered at Our Lady of Grace. We have a growing parish in all areas of our community, in all parts of our parish family. Our goal is to facilitate this growth while attending to the pastoral needs for Worship, Catechesis, and Fellowship while striving for a greater integration of our parish family, to bring all of the parts of our parish family together as a more integrated and cohesive family of faith. With this in mind it had become evident our current configuration of Mass times with Religious Education after the 9am only allowing those who attend the earlier Masses to participate in Religious Ed., or Credo Café or other options for similar opportunities. Also, the only available time for any kind of Sunday fellowship, forms of devotion are able to be celebrated after the 1pm Mass which places a greater burden on parishioners and families of time, travel, etc. The third immediate practical goal is to alleviate the parking difficulties created by the overlaps in Mass and Religious Education.

Weighing the results and comments from the survey and in consultation with the PLT and Pastoral Council we will be submitting to the Diocese for approval the new proposed Mass times for Sundays as the most prudent for Our Lady of Grace. We hope with Diocesan approval to implement the new schedule in July.
