School uniform

The uniform consists of:

Boys:

- Grey school trousers or in summer school short trousers
- St. Aidan's V neck sweatshirt/cardigan – available from Slaters*
- White shirt (long or short sleeved)
- Tie (from Y1 onwards) – available from Slaters*
- Plain grey/black socks
- Flat, dark sensible shoes – NO TRAINERS

Girls:

- Grey school pinafore dress, skirt or trousers, or in summer, a green gingham summer dress
- St. Aidan's V neck sweatshirt/cardigan – available from Slaters*
- White shirt/blouse (long or short sleeved)
- Tie (from Y1 onwards) – available from Slaters*
- Plain white or grey socks (knee length or ankle) or grey tights
- Flat, dark sensible shoes - NO TRAINERS

Items with an asterisk * are the only items that must have a school logo, or be bought from a specific uniform shop. All other items can be plain and bought from anywhere.

For health and safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn. The only jewellery which pupils are permitted to wear is a watch (avoid novelty types). Earrings of any kind, plastic or otherwise, are not permitted. If you wish to have your child's ears pierced please do so at the beginning of the school summer holidays so that they can be removed by the time school re-opens. If children are unable to remove their earrings they will not be able to play outside at break or take part in P.E lessons.
