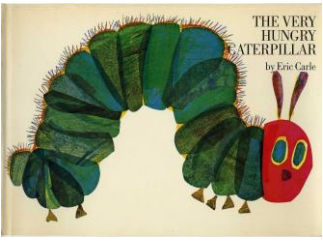
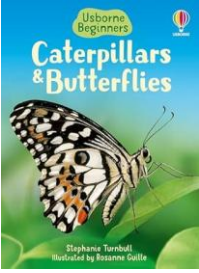
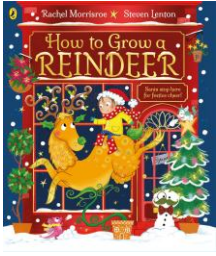

Genres Purpose	Retelling of the story - To entertain	The life cycle of a caterpillar - To inform	Instructions 'How to prepare for Father Christmas's arrival' - To inform
Composition and Effect	Orally plan and sequence ideas for writing. Use vocabulary from the stimulus.		
Proof-reading and Editing	Say a sentence and count the words. During shared writing, can support 'say it, count it, write it and check it.'		
Handwriting	Hold pencil with preferred grip and form lower case letters with developing accuracy Separate words with a prompt or spacer		
Sentence Structure	Orally compose and begin to write a simple sentence in response to a stimulus.		
Punctuation	Identify capital letters and full stops when reading Begin to use a capital letter and/or full stop when writing a sentence		
Cohesion and Coherence	Sequence pictures/events from a story and orally retell (may use and, then, next etc)		
Spelling	Phonetically plausible in line with what has been taught Spell and apply taught CEW.
