Day 1

FLIGHT FROM EDINBURGH TO WICK

18 HOLES ON THE WICK LINKS COURSE

We look forward to welcoming you to Wick Golf Club, the most northerly course on Scotland's east coast, where golf has been played since 1870. Take on the challenge of a traditional Scottish links with breathtaking views over Sinclair Bay to Noss Head and its historic castles. Enjoy this opportunity to experience history, golf and warm Highland hospitality.

- After your round, transfer to the airport located next to the golf course
- Flight to Benbecula (30 minutes)
- Transfer to Grogarry Lodge
- Overnight at Grogarry Lodge



Day 2

18 HOLES ON THE ASKERNISH LINKS COURSE

Askernish Golf Club is home to what has been described as “the most natural golf course in the world” and was ranked 86th in the Top 100 Links Courses in Great Britain & Ireland in 2015.

The course and club have a long, almost mythical history. Old Tom Morris travelled to South Uist in 1891 to create a course at the request of the wealthy landowner Lady Cathcart, who wished to impress her high-society guests. He laid out an 18-hole course that was maintained by local crofters until the early 1920s, when demand for golf declined and social pressures on the local community made upkeep no longer viable.

Over the next 80 years, nature reclaimed the land. The site survived as a 9-hole course with 18 tees and was even used as an airstrip. In 2005, a group of local residents decided to reclaim their course and began restoration work with the support of some of the biggest names in the golf industry. In 2008, the course reopened as a full 18-hole layout and has since received widespread acclaim from golf media around the world.

- Flight to Islay (26 minutes)
- Transfer to The Machrie Hotel
- Overnight at The Machrie Hotel



Day 3

18 HOLES ON THE MACHRIE LINKS COURSE

Golf has been played at The Machrie since 1891. Originally designed by Willie Campbell and more recently modernised by course architect DJ Russell, The Machrie blends the very best of a traditional, historic links from a bygone era with the qualities of a modern championship links.

The need for strategy, imagination and creativity has remained unchanged over the years and is just as relevant today as it was in 1891.

- After your round, transfer to the airport
- Flight to Campbeltown (12 minutes)
- Transfer to Ugadale Cottages
- Whisky tasting
- Overnight in Machrihanish



Day 4

18 HOLES ON THE MACHRIHANISH DUNES COURSE

The 7,082-yard links at Machrihanish Dunes flows effortlessly to, from and along the sea, inviting you to step back in time to the era when Old Tom Morris laid out the neighbouring links and Willie Campbell designed The Machrie on the nearby island of Islay — visible from the dunes of Machrihanish.

The routing, as well as the positioning of tees and greens, was dictated entirely by the natural contours of the land — and by the presence of several protected species of flora and fauna. Machrihanish Dunes is the only course ever created on a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI).

Because of the fragility of this unspoiled coastal environment, and in order to preserve the site's unique natural beauty, the course was built and is maintained with the lightest possible touch. Of the 259 acres on which the course sits, only seven — yes, seven — acres were shaped during construction. Only the tees and greens were formed. The fairways golfers walk on remain exactly as they were found, simply mown shorter.

Day 4 (continued)

9 HOLES ON THE DUNAVERTY COURSE

Dunaverty Golf Club is located near the village of Southend, in a stunning setting on the southern coast of the Kintyre peninsula. The course is a beautiful 18-hole, par-66 natural links stretching over 4,799 yards.

Spectacular views of Sanda Island to the south, Ailsa Craig and Ayrshire to the east, and Northern Ireland to the south-west enhance the pleasure of playing this technical and exceptionally well-maintained course. Cows roaming the fairways add a distinctive and memorable touch to the experience.

- 18:30: Dinner at the Old Tom Morris Pub
- 19:30: Transfer to Dunaverty
- 20:00: 9 holes on the Dunaverty course
- After your round, transfer back to Ugadale
- Overnight in Machrihanish



Day 5

18 HOLES ON THE MACHRIHANISH OLD COURSE

Machrihanish Golf Club is a classic Scottish links located in Machrihanish, at the southern tip of the Mull of Kintyre. The main course overlooks the west coast, with views towards the Paps of Jura and Ireland, and was ranked 39th best course outside the United States by Golf Digest in 2005. The opening hole in particular is often regarded as one of the finest opening holes in world golf.

The club was founded in 1876 as Kintyre Golf Club. The course originally featured ten holes before the club was officially established and was soon extended to twelve. In 1879, Old Tom Morris was brought in to redesign and expand it to 18 holes, including today's famous first hole. J.H. Taylor made further modifications in 1914, and in the 1940s Sir Guy Campbell shaped the course into its present configuration.

The club was ranked 57th in Golf Digest's 2015 list of the World's 100 Greatest Golf Courses.

- After your round, lunch at the clubhouse
- Transfer to Campbeltown Airport
- Return flight to Edinburgh
