A New Horizon:

Agapé's Bold Step Forward to Reach Women in a Post-Roe Era

hen the Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade, many believed it would mark the end of abortion. But the landscape is shifting. While surgical abortions may be harder to access, chemical abortions — abortion pills — are rapidly increasing. Over half of all U.S. abortions now occur through medication*, often ordered online and delivered discreetly to homes and dorms.

This reality is sobering. The ease, privacy, and accessibility of abortion pills are changing everything. Agapé is adapting. We now face a digital front line — where decisions happen on smartphones, often before a woman steps into a clinic. To meet this challenge, Agapé is launching a new marketing initiative to reach abortion-vulnerable women, including millennials, Gen Z, and younger Gen X — digital natives who value speed, authenticity, and connection.

Over half of U.S. abortions now occur through over-the-counter pills.

Our strategy includes:

- * A fresh, modern brand that reflects compassion, trust, and professionalism
- * A mobile-friendly website tailored to meet her in her moment of crisis
- * Targeted digital ads and social media, reaching her during online searches, often in the quiet of the night

We're also investing in cutting-edge staff training to understand today's woman — one who often feels overwhelmed, unsupported, and uncertain. She may be isolated, facing pressure, and seeking quick answers. This shift is part of our ongoing transformation. We've moved from Birthright to Agapé. Now, we're stepping into the next chapter: reaching abortion-vulnerable women in a post-Roe culture.

But we need your help.
