ICEBREAKER:

In what specific ways has God's generosity been evident in your life this past week?

DISCUSS/OBSERVE:

1. What does reading John 3:16 teach us about the God who created us in His image?
2. What examples from nature does Jesus use in Luke 12:24-28 to illustrate His daily provision for us?
3. In this message, we learned that every good gift is from God (James 1:17); how does that change your mindset from ownership to stewardship?
4. How does true contentment as described in Hebrews 13:5, free us to be more generous and obedient to God? What does it mean to be "free from love of money" in your personal life?
5. Using 1 Corinthians 4:7 as a lens, are there any gifts you have received that you are not actively stewarding well for God's purposes?
6. Reflecting on Acts 20:35, consider some practical ways you can experience the blessing of giving this week?

REFLECTION:

Consider – are you investing more in temporary comforts or things that matter eternally?

Write a prayer asking the Lord for a renewed heart this week that is content with God's provision and isn't always looking to new things for satisfaction.

APPLICATION:

Choose a verse that stood out to you this week to memorize. As you read it, thank God for things He revealed about Himself, confess any areas where you're struggling to live according to His word, and commit to following Him in ways He's prompting you.

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal anything you need to lay down in this season to guard your heart from materialism and simultaneously help you grow in generosity for His kingdom purposes.
