ROCKPOINTE'S HISTORY

The story of RockPointe Church began in 2001 when Ron and Allison Holton started to pray and dream of planting a new church - one with a simple but powerful mission: to love God with all that we are while making more and better followers of Christ.

An incredible journey began as the Lord provided, directed, and clarified the vision for RockPointe Church.

What started as a step of faith and a humble vision to reach the newly developed Lantana area has now grown into a movement far beyond what anyone could have imagined.

The story continues to unfold today in ways we never expected.





2002

- In March, fifteen people gathered for the first informational meeting.
- The first service at Lantana's Rayzor Elementary had about 80 attendees.

2007

- By God's grace and provision, our first building opened at the Central Campus in January.
- In the fall, our first church plant, CrossPointe Community Church in Corinth, launched weekly services.

- No longer able to meet at the elementary school, services were moved to Briarhill Middle School in Highland Village.

2003

- To provide a dedicated space for students and adults, our WestPointe building opened.

2010

- Over 2,000 people attend Easter services.

2013

- Fueled by God's faithfulness, we broke ground on the new worship center.

2015

- Building on our vision and commitment to church planting, The Well Community Church was established in Argyle.

- Due to extensive growth, we began a campaign to build additional spaces for worship, preschool, and adult education.

- In February, the first services in the new worship center hosted over 1,400 attendees.

- Responding to the need for more space to support growth, the Parker Square Campus opened its doors in June.

- Expanding beyond Texas, CrossFields Church was planted in Cleveland, OH in July.



Our secondary goal is to raise **\$33 million** over the next two years in order to accomplish these three initiatives:



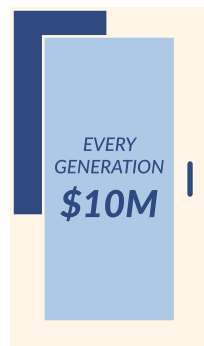
OPENING DOORS TO **EVERYDAY MINISTRIES**

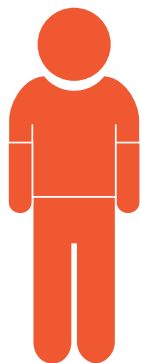

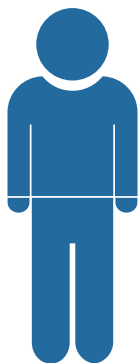

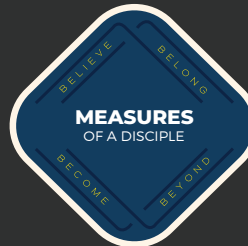

RockPointe will increase our efforts in local church planting, giving a new church greater support than ever before.

In the coming decades, over 100,000 new residents are expected to move into southwest Denton County.

Flower Mound's Furst Ranch development alone is projected to add over 20,000 new residents in the coming decades.

RockPointe is positioned to make a significant impact with intentional church planting in this time and place of high growth.



In 2020, RockPointe set a goal to plant or assist a total of 50 churches by the end of the decade. Today, our church is right on schedule to plant 10 new churches by 2030.

Over the past two decades, RockPointe has been a significant part of **24 new churches** and ministry expressions. Half of those have already started new churches of their own!

Wellspring • China Spring, TX

In 2021, RockPointe launched Wellspring, which also involved sending out both of our worship ministers! This was an expansion on multiple fronts as RockPointe opened the Parker Square Campus that same year. Today, Wellspring's worship services reach 600 congregants from the greater Waco area.



CrossFields • North Royalton, OH

Our most recent church plant, CrossFields, held its first public worship services in September! Kevin grew up near Cleveland, Ohio, and never heard the gospel message while living there, which compelled the Kowalskis to move back to this area of great spiritual need.

Harvest Ministries • Little Elm, TX

Harvest Ministries has grown to reach 250 in worship in just two years. But what's really worth celebrating are the 68 people who now profess Jesus as their Savior, and 42 who have followed Him publicly through believer's baptism!



The Well • Argyle, TX

Launched in 2015, The Well is now bursting at the seams with 1,800 congregants across 4 weekend services. Simultaneously, they have set their vision beyond Argyle—accelerating efforts to plant several new churches over the next 10 years.

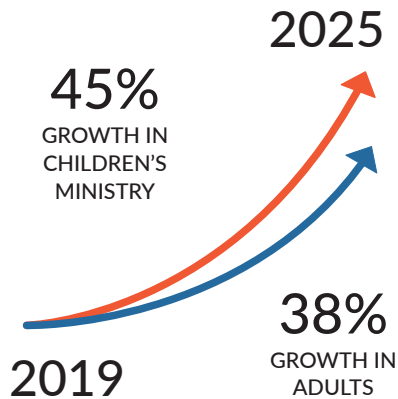

GIVING DISCIPLESHIP JOURNEY

Whether the concept of biblical stewardship is brand new or you've been giving for decades, our prayer is that God would help each of us grow in our faith and generosity for the sake of Jesus and his mission. Where are you today on your giving journey? Where do you believe God may be calling you?

AN INITIAL GIVER

is someone who decides to give for the first time in response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trusts both God and church leaders with their gift. They experience the initial joy of putting Jesus' words into action (Matthew 7:24).

A CONSISTENT GIVER

is someone who decides to give on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving as a follower of Jesus. Choosing to make their gift an online recurring gift is a helpful way to stay consistent! Non-online givers can be consistent givers as well of course; it just requires more discipline (2 Corinthians 8:7).



A PRIORITY GIVER

is someone who starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they prioritize and spend their money. Giving becomes the first consideration before other spending or even saving (Matthew 6:19-21).

A SURRENDERED GIVER

is someone who desires to surrender all to Him, honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result (Ephesians 5:1-2). This giver might say, "My giving is not just changing my spending and saving. It's also changing me!" They also look at what they're not giving away and ask, "Is it surrendered too?"

AN ETERNAL GIVER

is someone who sees the eternal impact of their giving – on them and on others – not just the immediate programs and ministries it helps accomplish. They think of what home they buy, what car they purchase, how much savings they choose to keep, all in relation to their generosity capacity. An eternal giver is driven by the things of eternity, putting their hope in God and not in the things of this earth (1 Timothy 6:19).

WHY ONE FUND?

You may have been part of church campaigns in the past where you were asked to give a second gift “above and beyond” your usual gifts to complete special projects. At RockPointe, these have been used to make new buildings and ministries possible. Normally, you gave that gift to the “Building Fund” and you also continued to give to the “General Fund.”

This type of giving is potentially confusing to people who either don’t have a baseline for their “usual giving” or who aren’t able to really celebrate the total giving at RockPointe in one single number. We believe we’re all on ONE MISSION – the mission of making more and better followers of Christ.

The Opening Doors initiative will last two years. During this time, every gift given to RockPointe Church will go to the Opening Doors initiative – to help us faithfully trust God in our everyday ministries, everywhere God leads, and for every generation.

FAQs

What are you asking me to do?

We are asking you to join us in prayer throughout the Opening Doors initiative. Pray expectantly that God would do abundantly more than we can ask, think, or imagine. Pray that He will deepen your love and devotion to Him and lead you and your family to commitment during this season at RockPointe. Pray and seek God's leading on what He is asking of you.

Prepare your heart to hear Him and then listen to what He says. Engage in a small group during this season, if you haven't already. Spend time in personal reflection with God through this guide. Talk with your spouse, your family, friends, or others about what this commitment will mean for this next exciting season of your life.

We are also asking that you make a sacrificial commitment to gospel-driven, surrendered generosity. Whatever it is that God leads you to do, follow His leading. We are seeking 100% engagement from our church family, and we invite you to ask God what it looks like to cheerfully give your first and best in this season.

We want you to be ready for what God is going to do through Commitment Sunday. We serve an awesome God who is moving in powerful ways, and we anticipate an unprecedented impact from our collective Opening Doors commitments - something only He can do. Mark your calendar for Sunday, November 2, and prepare to experience a life-changing worship service that will be remembered as a defining moment for our church and for our faith.

Are there additional ways besides cash that I can give more towards Opening Doors?

Yes, be creative as you explore ways you and your family can give towards Opening Doors. You may have some stored resources that God has blessed you with in the past that He might be calling you to give out of during this time. You might have some stocks, property, or other items of that nature. Please let us know if you need assistance with facilitating gifts of property or stock, and we would be happy to help you with that. How long is my commitment?

We are asking everyone to make a two-year commitment. The fulfillment period of your commitment will begin in December 2025 and culminate in December 2027.

What if I have never even given to RockPointe before?

Opening Doors was crafted specifically with you in mind. Opening Doors is a “one fund” generosity initiative, meaning that it is different from a traditional capital campaign where you are called to give an extra gift above and beyond your normal giving. Opening Doors is a call to sacrificial, gospel-driven generosity for absolutely everyone at RockPointe. If you have never given before, this is your chance to get in the game with committed giving. We really hope you will.

What if I am new around here?

Opening Doors is about the vision for our church and our personal discipleship in giving as followers of Jesus. We believe that the local church is one of the most compelling missions to give towards, and we would really love for you to make RockPointe your home and join us in Opening Doors. If you are ready for it, this is a perfect time for you to put a stake in the ground and make RockPointe your church. We need you on the team!

If we are committing to Opening Doors, how does this change my giving to missions, the operations fund, and other special offerings or designated gifts?

During this two-year period, every contribution to God through RockPointe is a contribution to our Opening Doors initiative. Every aspect of the ministry vision God is calling us towards for the next two years will be funded through Opening Doors. There will not be separate funds. Every gift made will go into the same fund and will be our Opening Doors giving. Therefore, every weekend becomes a day to celebrate and contribute toward what God is doing in us and through us to help navigate people to God.
