  - What was the response of the fishermen (who were fishing for fish) to Jesus's call to them?
  - What did the things they left represent?
  - What does it mean to follow Jesus in your life?
  - What are you holding on to in your life that is preventing you from fully following Jesus?
  - Have you decided to follow Jesus? Why or why not?
- **Read Colossians 3:23-24.** According to this passage, how can you battle the desire to "fit in" or belong?
- What might Jesus be calling you to on your team?
