Description:

The Band program offers instruction on woodwind, brass, and percussion instruments, and will develop the skills necessary for long-term student success in middle and high school band programs. Band A is for the absolute beginner. NO EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED. Band A students may choose from the following instruments: flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, or percussion.

All students will need to purchase or rent their own instrument and equipment once enrollment and instrument selection are confirmed.

Fee:

- \$450 one-time fee
- AFTER instrument selection has been completed and confirmed by Ms. Natalie (week of 9/1/25), we will bill your account.

Band A – Beginner: 4th through 8th Grade

An interview is required after Pre-Enrollment. Official Enrollment is provisional. Ms. Natalie will help students and parents pick which instrument to purchase or rent.

Attendance:

- Students are expected to have all necessary materials: their instrument, music, and a pencil.
- Regular attendance is required NO PARTIAL ENROLLMENT, and students who miss will fall behind in class, impairing his/her ability to improve and feel confident.
- If your child is going to miss rehearsal, notify Ms. Natalie via email.
- If your child misses more than two rehearsals in a month and Ms. Natalie feels they are falling behind, then private coaching during lunch for a fee will be recommended.
- Habitual absences will result in a conference with parents and possible dismissal.
- Participation in the Winter Concert and Spring Concert is mandatory, and attendance at scheduled rehearsals is also required. We are a team and rely on everyone to be there.

Home Practice:

- Practice is crucial to your child's confidence and success in Band.
- If your child will not be able to commit to regular practice of 20 minutes a day, then **DO NOT** register for band.
- Subject to availability, additional coaching sessions with Ms. Natalie can be arranged for a fee
- All band books come with access to MP3 files, and all students will be expected to use them.

Behavior:

- Students are expected to follow all Monticello Academy policies.
- Students are expected to be good representatives of Monticello Academy when working with guest instructors.
- If your child is disruptive in rehearsal, he/she will be asked to leave, and you will be notified via email or phone call.
- If a second incident occurs, then we will have a conference to discuss his/her future participation in the Band.
- Dismissal from Band is at the sole discretion of Ms. Natalie.

Policy:

- Tuition will be billed to your monthly invoice.
- Tuition is Non-Refundable, Non-Transferable, and Non-Prorated.
- A 30-day notice is required for any withdrawal or changes. All notices must be emailed to <u>ATTENDANCE</u> and <u>BAND DIRECTOR</u>
- The school **DOES NOT** accept any verbal notice.
- NO-Make-up Class unless the instructor reschedules the class.
