Music is extremely beneficial in early childhood education for children 2-5 years old. Not only does it impact their cognitive development, but also develops their social, emotional, motivational, gross and fine motor, body image, and auditory-perceptual skills. The overall goal for our young musicians is to have fun while learning!

2-3-year-old Class Objectives: *(Subject to change)*

Week 1 - Week 3:

- Move to music / Dancing
- Sing loudly and quietly
- Learn and develop listening skills

Week 4 - Week 6

- Introduction to various instruments: shakers, drums, scarves, rain sticks, parachutes, balloons, and bells.
- Play instruments / Creating music (Found Sound Band)
- Create hand movements to different songs.

Week 7 - Week 10

- Learning pitch (high/low), beat (fast/slow), and volume (loud/soft)
- Learning nursery rhymes
- Recognizing a variety of sounds / Sound Sorting
- Music expression



4-5-year-old Class Objectives: (Subject to change)

Week 1 - Week 3:

- Relationship between word meanings and following directions
- Clapping syllables
- Improve listening skills
- Echo sing and speak

Week 4 - Week 6

- Learn about beats, harmony, notes, rhythm, pitch, and genre
- Reinforcing the Steady Beat
- Sound Sorting
- Musical contrasts

Week 7 - Week 8

- Re-telling stories
- Memorization of songs
- Using different instruments: shakers, drums, scarves, rain sticks, parachutes, bells, balloons, and chimes/xylophone.
- Play instruments while singing

Week 9 - Week 10

- Create movements in response to music (Guided Movement)
- Draw What You Hear
- Vocal exploration
- Music expression
- Dynamics and tempo
