These experiences help build foundational skills essential for future learning, including cutting, gluing, painting, and drawing—all of which support prewriting abilities and the development of expressive language, emotions, and vocabulary.

Our program nurtures emotional growth and social skills by providing a fun and engaging outlet where children gain confidence and a sense of achievement in their artwork. They learn to share, collaborate, and respect others, whether working individually or in groups. Their boundless creativity and imagination are celebrated as they bring their ideas to life. Monticello Academy's preschool art program also lays the groundwork for school readiness by helping children develop attention span, task completion, and the ability to follow directions.
