Following God's example of Love, we can Love Him with all our heart, soul, and mind, and our neighbors as ourselves. Recently, our students began a study through the Gospel of Mark. In chapter 4, Jesus teaches one of His most well-known parables: the Parable of the Sower. This passage is often called the Parable of the Soils, and for good reason, as the focus of the parable is the condition of the soil – because soil determines how the seed is received. In this parable, each type of soil represents a different response to the truth of God's Word.

1- The Path: the heart that rejects God's Word outright. Because the truth never takes root, the enemy comes and takes it away.

2- The Rocky Soil: the heart that responds with excitement when God's Word is convenient or emotionally stirring. But when trouble or persecution arises because of the Word, there is no depth, and the person quickly falls away.

3- The Thorns: the heart which hears the Word, but becomes distracted by the cares of this world, the pursuit of comfort, and the lure of temporary satisfaction. Thus, God's Word is choked out resulting in no fruit.

4- the Good Soil: the heart who hears God's Word, welcomes it, and allows it to take root. The result is a life that produces fruit – evidence of God's transforming work.

Jesus came to teach us the truth about our need for a Savior and His work to meet that need. This truth – the gospel – is not something we outgrow or move beyond. It is something we need to be reminded of every day.

Only as we continually return to the gospel can we position ourselves to live lives worthy of it, as the apostle Paul urges believers to do. Jesus not only provided the means of our salvation; He came to reveal and teach us how we can experience its power in our lives. The question Jesus leaves us with is a simple but searching one: *Are you willing to listen?*

What are you allowing to be your teacher in life? Often, the answer becomes clear when we look honestly at what we prioritize. What receives our time, attention, and energy reveals what we

value most. Is God and His Word your highest priority, or is it the first thing set aside at the slightest inconvenience?

God calls us to be His children – His disciples – not only when it is easy, but also when it is difficult.

The things we are willing to sacrifice for, the things we endure hardship for, reveal what truly matters to us. May we be people who are committed to the hard work of cultivating hearts of good soil – ready to hear, receive, and live out the truth of God's Word so that it bears lasting fruit in our lives.
