Dear brothers and sisters,

This coming week we are celebrating a saint that is similar in some ways to St. Mary Magdalene, namely St., Ignatius of Loyola. I say this because he came from a spiritual place, like St. Mary Magdalene, that was very far from God.

St. Ignatius is a perfect example of how something bad can lead to something good. He was living a very crude life as a soldier but did not consider God as worthy of his attention in any real way until he was badly injured. God invited him into a deeper relationship through the women that were taking care of him in the hospital.

Sometimes we think that one person can't do much to change the world. St. Ignatius shows us how much God can change the world through one person when that person is listening attentively to God's voice.

*St. Ignatius, as he grew spiritually, came to develop for us the **Spiritual Exercises** in order to help us listen to God also. A few great resources are: www.omvusa.org (And you can see their Virtual Workshops for healing).*

Also, Fr. Timothy Gallagher, OVM has numerous books on the Spiritual exercises. One great one is: Discerning the Will of God: An Ignatian Guide to Christian Decision Making.

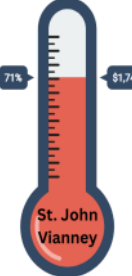

Dios lo invitó a una relación más profunda a través de las mujeres que lo cuidaban en el hospital.
