Pastor's Reflection

Dear parishioners,

Because the Solemnity of All Saints day, November 1st, falls on a Saturday this year, it is NOT a holy day of obligation. But we will be having a Mass on Saturday morning, November 1, at 9 a.m. at St. Mary to celebrate all of the great saints we hold dear.

The kids will come dressed as saints and share a little about their saint. Also, the night before we will be having a trunk or treat event in which the kids can come dressed as a saint at St. Cecilia. It is a good way for the kids to think about the saints in a way that they can model in their own life.

From our pilgrimage to Lourdes there is a quote from St. Bernadette that has remained in my mind ever since we were there. When she was being investigated by the local city officials and also by many bishops and representatives of the church she would say to them, “my job is to inform, not to convince.” I love that quote because it forces the people of authority to remember that their job is not to dissect her life like a specimen, but rather to come to a place of belief rooted in faith. Her job was to help them have more faith, not less faith. This is a great way of remembering our own job of holiness each day. It is not to so convince people that they actually need no faith, but to inform them of God’s love and presence then expect them to respond in faith.

Queridos parroquianos,

Dado que la Solemnidad de Todos los Santos, el 1 de noviembre, cae en sábado este año, no es día de precepto. Sin embargo, celebraremos una misa el sábado 1 de noviembre a las 9 a. m. en Santa María para celebrar a todos los grandes santos que apreciamos tanto. Los niños vendrán vestidos de santos y compartirán un poco sobre su santo. Además, la noche anterior tendremos una fiesta de "truck or treat" en la que los niños podrán venir vestidos de santos a Santa Cecilia. Es una buena manera de que los niños reflexionen sobre los santos de una manera que puedan modelar en su propia vida.

De nuestra peregrinación a Lourdes, hay una cita de Santa Bernardita que ha permanecido en mi mente desde que estuvimos allí. Cuando estaba siendo investigada por las autoridades municipales y también por muchos obispos y representantes de la iglesia, les decía: "Mi trabajo es informar, no convencer". No se trata de convencer a la gente de que en realidad no necesita fe, sino de informarles del amor y la presencia de Dios y esperar que respondan con fe.
