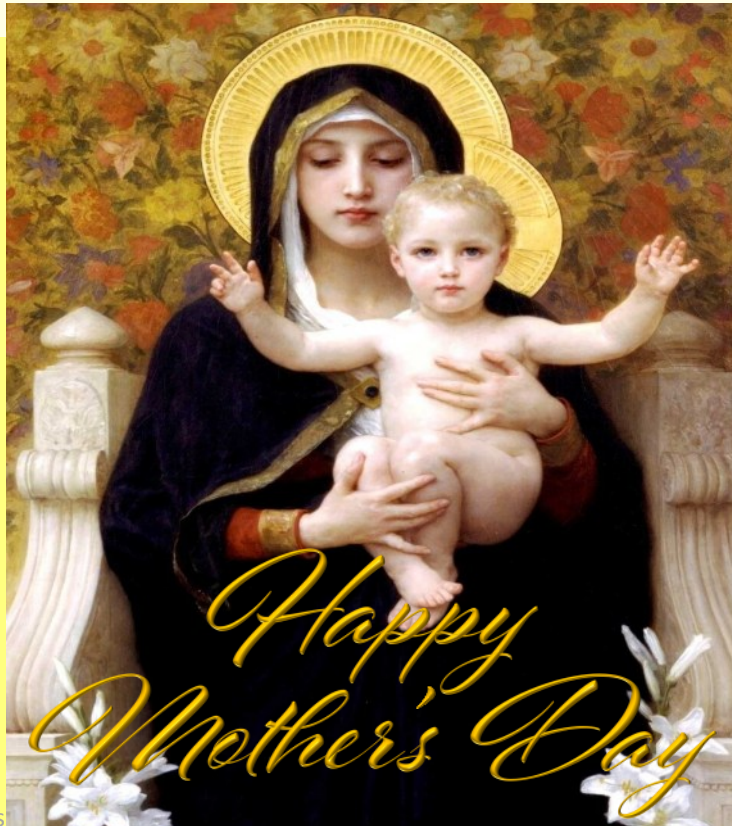

Mount Angel Abbey Pilgrimage Retreat

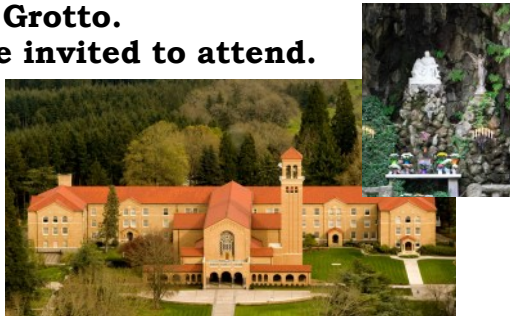
