

## Reflexión del pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

A principios de esta semana leíamos sobre Pablo y Bernabé, quienes regresaban a Jerusalén llevando fondos de ayuda y provisiones de parte de la comunidad católica de Antioquía. Esto se debía a que los católicos estaban siendo perseguidos en Jerusalén y necesitaban ayuda. Uno de los grandes dones de la Iglesia es la manera en que podemos ayudar a los demás, contribuyendo así a edificar a toda la Iglesia, además de a nuestras propias comunidades.

Les mencioné que, a partir de esta semana, estamos llevando a cabo la Campaña Católica Anual. Esta es una forma en la que podemos imitar a Pablo y a Bernabé al ayudar a otras comunidades. La Arquidiócesis de Seattle es el vínculo que nos une a todos. Cada año, ellos pueden aprovechar nuestra ayuda para realizar aquellas obras que nosotros, por nuestra cuenta, no podríamos llevar a cabo. Parte de estos fondos se destina a ayudar a las parroquias misioneras que tienen dificultades para sostenerse económicamente. También se utiliza para ayudar a nuestros seminaristas a cubrir los costos de su formación académica y sus gastos personales. Siempre estuve profundamente agradecido por toda su generosidad durante los siete años en que fui seminarista; y esa generosidad continúa siendo de inmensa ayuda para ellos mientras avanzan en sus estudios.
