

# The **Ultimate** wedding stationery timeline checklist

## You're engaged

- Start planning your wedding stationery suite.
- Order your save the dates.
- Allow plenty of time to confirm your guest list.
- Choose your wedding style. (Align your designs with your theme, colour palette, and venue.)

## 12 months to go

- Send your save the dates. (Especially important for destination weddings or weddings during peak season.)
- Gives guests time to book time off work.
- Allows guests to arrange travel.
- Helps guests secure accommodation early.

## 8 months to go

- Order your wedding invitations.
- Finalise key details, including: Ceremony time, Venue addresses, Accommodation information, Gift lists and RSVP deadlines
- Consider including matching: Details cards, RSVP cards, Menus and Information inserts

## 5 months to go

- Send your wedding invitations. (Give guests plenty of time to respond.)
- Start tracking RSVPs.
- Record dietary requirements.
- Note any special requests.

## 2 months to go

- Create your keepsakes and on-the-day stationery.
- Include items such as: Order of service booklets, Welcome signs, Table numbers, Place cards, Menus and Vow book
- Add personalised touches to tie your wedding styling together seamlessly.

## one month to go

- Order your table plan and final ceremony details once RSVPs are confirmed.
- Double-check spellings of guest names.
- Review seating arrangements.
- Confirm final guest numbers with your venue and suppliers.
