


Q1 How often do you visit our city parks?






Updated Flooring at HPCC



Q3 Which amenities in our parks do you use the most?





Q5 How would you rate the overall cleanliness and maintenance of our parks?





"The Director does a great job and I can't think of anything more she could do."


"Could you some updates in some areas....in the interiors. Maybe invest in a run of pipe-and-drape to cover the history' mural for private party/reception rentals."




Q10 Would you be interested in pickleball courts?

Answered: 233 Skipped: 6



Answered: 230 Skipped: 9








