## Pickleball Courts

The Beech Grove Parks Foundation is seeking support to build three pickleball courts at Sarah T. 


## HPCC Banquet Hall Upgrades

The Beech Grove Banquet Hall is one of the community's most frequently used public spaces, serving everything from youth programs and senior activities to civic meetings, celebrations, trainings, and large scale community events. After years of constant use, the facility needs upgrades that improve functionality, accessibility, comfort, and overall appearance. Modernizing the hall will allow the city to host more programs, attract outside rentals that support revenue growth, and provide a welcoming environment that reflects the pride residents have in their community. Sponsorship support will help refresh walls, lighting, furnishings, and equipment so the space can continue to meet the diverse needs of families, organizations, and visitors. An improved banquet hall strengthens the entire Hornet Park campus by giving Beech Grove a high quality gathering space that is ready for the next generation of community events.


#### Touch-a-Truck
