2024-2025 Fiscal Year Highlights

HIGHLIGHTS

- Sold the land across the street for \$449,000.
- Paid off the rectory loan.
- Substantial progress made on the church building loan (a \$586,281 decrease!)
- Hosted our first ever Musical Mashup to showcase the talents of our musicians and raised \$19,000 for the debt.
- Obtained a St. Henry Relic.
- Held a successful St. Heinrich's Fest in honor of our patron and fundraised \$23,700 for operations (this will show on next year's financial report.)
- Our Latino Community held a music concert fundraiser, "A Summer at the Father's House," which raised over
 \$4,000 for the debt.

DEBT

Church loan balance \$737,628 as of 6/30/25, fiscal year end. Current loan balance is \$600,961 as of 10/31/2025.

REDUCTION OF

\$136,667 in the last four months

OPERATIONS

Our Sunday offering/plate collection was \$995,978 which was 91.7% of the \$1,086,500 budgeted goal.

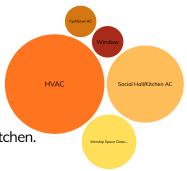
Absorbed the shortfall in Sunday offering/plate collection due to reduced expenses in payroll and interest savings on the building loan due to progress on the principal. Also reduced expenses for our copier and garbage service, saving the parish \$675 per month.

MAINTENANCE

We received \$126.605 in maintenance funds.

Maintenance Projects completed:

- Replacing Fyshbowl/youth room window.
- Added air conditioning to the Fyshbowl Youth Room and the Social Hall Kitchen.
- Started the HVAC replacement, replaced 2 furnaces and condenser.
- Cleaning of beams and windows in the worship space.
