- 1 A copy of your official school transcript from freshman year up to and including senior mid-terms and GPA

 - school extracurricular activities, including any positions held
 - community service activities, including length of service
 - any additional activities, interests, or special circumstances you feel could assist the Scholarship Committee as they review your application

- 4 A letter of recommendation from either a teacher, coach, advisor, or guidance counselor
- 5 A short essay (between 250 and 300 words) of your academic goals and why you think this scholarship should be awarded to you
