EVENT OVERVIEW

The Australian Teams Carnival and the Australian Individual Championships are owned by Tennis Seniors Australia which allocates it annually on a rotational basis to the member states (New South Wales, Victoria, Tasmania, South Australia, Western Australia, Australian Capital Territory and Queensland).

In 2027, the event headquarters will be District Park (Corner of Lambton Rd & Curley Rd Broadmeadow), which is a licensed premises with 23 synthetic grass courts.

Over 60 courts will be used in the first week.

TEAMS CARNIVAL

The first week of the event is the Teams Carnival where men and women, in teams of five to six players, compete in age groups (30+ to 90+) against teams from all states, as well as from overseas. In past years, teams have entered from New Zealand, Malaysia, China and USA. More than 700 players are expected to compete in the Teams event, and many will be accompanied by their partners and family members.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

In the week following the Teams Carnival, the International Tennis Federation (ITF) sanctioned "MT1000" Australian Seniors Tennis Championships will be held, offering players world ranking points for the more serious men and women tennis players in age groups from 30+ to 90+. More than 400+ players from throughout Australia and overseas are expected to take part in the singles, doubles and mixed doubles knockout and round robin events.
