Engagement 2: Reflect

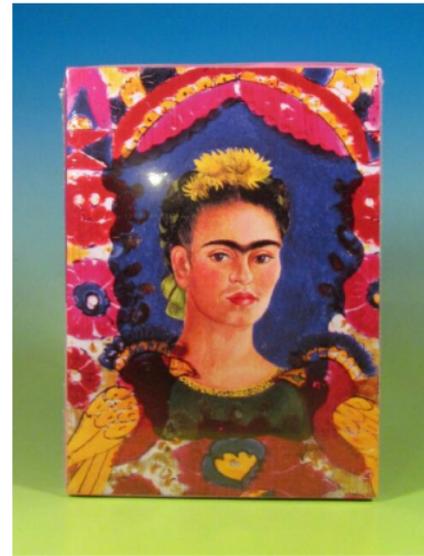

Engagement 3: Create

Now it's time to create your own Goalkeeper self portrait and your first plan of action. Using your notebook, a piece of paper, or a drawing app on an electronic or mobile device, title your paper with the word Goalkeeper, followed by your name. Then create your self portrait in any way that suits you. You can be abstract, traditional, you can use the words you identified earlier, or even use a printed picture of yourself and surround it with things that contribute to your perception of self! Be sure to leave room at the bottom or on the back for your plan of action.

Finally, at the bottom of your self portrait or on a separate sheet of paper, create your Goalkeeper plan of action. We love to use the **S.M.A.R.T. method** when making plans to help reach our goals.

Specific | What will you specifically do to be a Goalkeeper?

Measurable | How will you know you have succeeded?

Attainable | Be sure your goal is attainable — do you have the resources, time, money, experience, to make your plan a reality?

Relevant | Does your plan mean something to you? Do something that makes your heartbeat a little faster. It should be something you are excited to do!

Timely | Can you meet your goal in a reasonable amount of time?

Feel free to use the sample Goalkeeper statement and Plan of Action to help you make yours!

Sample Goalkeeper Statement: As a Goalkeeper, I want to make people aware of why taking care of our earth matters.

SAMPLE Plan of Action:

1. *Specific:* I will use my creativity to take pictures of me and my family cleaning up a local park, or beach, or walking path.
2. *Measurable:* We will be successful when we fill one trash bag full of trash and another bag full of recycling, and when we have 4 images that show the following:
 - The area before we clean it.
 - Images of us collecting, sorting, throwing away, and recycling trash
 - A picture of the area after we have cleaned it.
3. *Attainable:* We can definitely do this because there is a park nearby and my friends/guardians and I like to get outside on the weekend. We also already have trash bags and gloves for cleanup.
4. *Relevant:* This is meaningful to me because I want everyone I know to take care of our earth. I can ask my parents/guardians to share the images of our cleanup efforts on their social media and to the Rock Your Rights gallery.
5. *Timely:* This can easily be done in the near future. I just have to ask my guardians, siblings and/or friends and be sure that we all wear masks.
