Dear parishioners and guests,

Happy and blessed Easter! Christ is risen; alleluia!

In a marvelous fulfillment of his ancient promise to give his people a savior, God the Father has sent his Son, not only to take our human nature to himself, but even to bear the burden of the sins of all humanity. And that same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, took those sins – *our* sins, that is – to the Cross and suffered its agony in the greatest outpouring of love and mercy in all of history.

As with Lazarus and his illness, Jesus’ suffering did not *end* in death – it led *through* death to his glorious Resurrection, which we celebrate with highest honor, praise, and exultation today. Jesus Christ is risen from the dead; he is indeed risen; alleluia!

I am lifting you up in prayer today, especially asking God that, if you are burdened by pains or sorrows, he might shine the light of the Resurrection into that place of suffering. I pray that the joy we experience in the liturgy today might permeate our celebrations at home: our Easter egg hunts, our Easter dinners, our family time spent together, our time alone in quiet reflection.

Brothers and sisters, let’s not lose sight of the reason for our joy! Through the Sacraments of the Church, we have access in the most real way to the Paschal Mystery, that is, to the saving love flowing from Jesus’ pierced side and the life literally radiating (see the Shroud of Turin!) from his tomb.

If you didn’t notice, I’ll mention it here: all the celebrations of the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Easter Sunday) include the Eucharist. The very events we celebrate in the Sacred Triduum – the Last Supper, the Passion, Death, and Resurrection – are made *present* in the Eucharist. Therefore, the Second Vatican Council rightly called the Eucharist the *source and summit* of the Christian life, since the Church draws her life from the Eucharist (i.e., the source) and is oriented to the fullness of union with God, which is foreshadowed in the Eucharist (i.e., the summit).

I encourage you to consider the correlation between the regular (at least weekly) celebration of the Eucharist and the presence of Easter joy in your life. Do you want more joy? Make the Eucharist more central! The Risen Lord Jesus comes to you there; alleluia!

A light dinner is provided.*

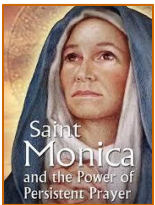


### Calling for suggestions!
