Greetings to the Catholic community of Stevens County. What a warm welcome I have received from so many of you these last few days. You make me feel right at home! It has been a

delight getting to know you, and I look forward to the ways in which the Lord will strengthen and nurture the friendships we have already begun.

For those of you who do not know me, my name is Andrew Kelley, and I am a seminarian for the Diocese of Spokane. For the last five years, I have studied philosophy and theology at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park, CA. I have faith that your constant prayers for vocations have buoyed me along in hidden, but powerful ways. Thank you for your ongoing spiritual support!

The path that brings me to Colville this summer is long and winding. I grew up in rural Western Oregon, the eldest son of a long line of farmers, loggers, and nurserymen. I attended Gonzaga University, graduating in 2020 with a BA in music. I was applying for graduate schools to study classical voice and opera when I experienced a spiritual revival and renewed love for God and for our Catholic faith. The spark that ignited that fire came when I decided that my Lenten practice one year would be to attend Holy Mass every day. Hearing the Word of God and receiving that same Word in the Eucharist did things to my heart that I probably still don't fully understand. All I know is that my life was heading in one direction before that Lent, and another direction afterwards. It took some time for me to realize that a change had happened within me. But a change did, indeed, take place, and that season of conversion culminated in the decision to enter a program of priestly formation for the Diocese of Spokane.

Five years as a seminarian have flown by. Thanks be to God that it has led me here to Colville, to you. As a mere seminarian, there is a lot I cannot do. I cannot celebrate the Mass and I cannot hear your confession. But these things I can do: meet up for a friendly cup of coffee; go for a ride with other cycling enthusiasts and swap stories in the saddle; and I'm pretty good at coming over to people's houses and eating barbeque!

I thank the good Lord for granting me the opportunity to follow in the footsteps of your beloved Fr. Kenny. Pray for me that I, like him, may imitate our Lord's example of selfforgetful love, seeking to become ever more a man after Christ's heart. Be assured of my prayers for each of you.
