Dear parishioners and guests,

When I'm not touring the countryside with your local, priestly road warrior, Fr. Kenny, I spend my time plugging away at a couple pet projects. One of them

includes my thesis for my seminary degree, which, in my case, involves a deep dive into the writings of St. Gregory of Nyssa, whose 4th century teaching on Christian prayer is of particular interest to me.

Gregory's writing is not always clear and is seldom concise. He prefers to make his point with poetic and illustrative prose rather than with tight, efficient lines of reasoning. He's as much an artist as he is a theologian. He is captivated by the notion that the Christian life is a process of living and dying; we desire a new and joyful life in Christ, but he can only come to us if we, with the help of God's grace, put to death our own selfishness. We must die to ourselves so that Christ may live in us and we in him.

I came across a beautiful line of text this week that, I think, sums up Gregory's point. It was written about Mary Magdalene, whose feast day we celebrate this week: "Jesus is her life and, though she may seem alive, it is not she who lives; it is Jesus who lives in her (Gal 2:20). And so she is living and not living, living and dying, all at the same time. For Jesus who is her life is alive in her only to make her die. O living death and dying life!"

Mary Magdalene knew, perhaps, better than anyone in the Gospel, what it meant to die to a former way of life in order to find life anew in Christ. And she knew that she didn't have to do that on her own, relying solely on her own strength; Jesus was giving her strength, giving her his own life to help her and sustain her in her death to self.

Mary Magdalene lights the way for us and gives us hope that our death to self will not be in vain, but is accomplished only because God wants to give us something infinitely greater: His very own divine life and divine love.

Sts. Mary Magdalene and Gregory of Nyssa... Pray for us!
