I've thought about that interaction often over the years. How was it that that old man could see plainly the turmoil and confusion in my heart? I didn't go to any of those music schools after all, and instead went to the seminary, trying to find what I was "looking for," I guess. I didn't know what that was, but I was sure looking.

My summer here in Stevens and Ferry Counties has been filled with one joyful and wonderous moment after another, reminding me that it is in this life, headed for priestly ordination in the Diocese of Spokane, that the Lord is leading me to the things I've been "looking for." The Lord has used you, your homes, and your families to bless me immensely and remind me of how deeply I want to be a priest for this diocese, a priest for you! I'll leave a little piece of my heart here in this community. I hope to come back and tend to it every once and a while. In the meantime, I'd be grateful if you'd take care of it for me by sending up a prayer on my behalf every so often. Be assured of mine for you.
