Dear parishioners and guests,

In this Sunday's column, I hope to conclude my comments on *sola scriptura* — the theological theory that the Bible is the only authoritative source of Christian teaching in matters of doctrine and morals. We have

seen various problems with the theory, ranging from interpretation and translation of the Bible to the question of the Bible's composition. Today, we'll look at one final issue.

There are people who will invoke the Holy Spirit as the one who guarantees that their translation or interpretation of Scripture is authentic. For example, you might say to someone: "You say that Jesus was speaking figuratively or symbolically when He said, 'Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you have no life within you.' How do you know He wasn't speaking more literally?" And the person might respond, "When I prayed about it, the Holy Spirit showed me that that was how the passage should be understood." How can you argue with that?!

Actually, you can argue with that – well, maybe argue is the wrong word, but you can certainly challenge the assertion. I always take with a grain of salt a person's statement that begins with, "God told me ..." It's not that I deny that God speaks to us individually in the depths of our hearts; it's that our perception of God's movement or communication is not always 100% accurate. One of my priest friends always says, "Beware of people who are absolutely sure of their own discernment!"

Even if sola scriptura adherents believe that it's actually the Holy Spirit who is the ultimate authority behind the Bible's teachings, it's a huge leap to claim that their own understanding is infallible (without error) because the Holy Spirit guides them personally and individually.

With this claim, we run into the same problem we ran into when it came to the translation or the interpretation of the Bible: what happens when one person's "Holy Spiritinspired" reading conflicts with another person's reading that is supposedly inspired by the same Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Truth; the Spirit cannot be the source of contradictions.

Only the Church – and not the members of the Church individually – can rightfully make the claim that her reading of Scripture is infallible. Not only did the New Testament come into existence through the Church; Jesus also gave the Church the authority to continue teaching in His name, which includes interpreting the Scriptures for every generation. What a gift we have in the Church, that we can turn to her to help us understand the Word, and we don't have to rely solely on our own ability to interpret it.

### **Mystery of Faith Series: Angels**

On Tuesday, November 14 part two of the series on Angels. Here are some of the topics that we will discuss: The nine choirs of angels in descending order are: Seraphim, Cherubim, Thrones, Dominions, Virtues, Powers, Principalities, Archangels and Angels. The nine choirs are broken into three groups of three. The first group of three are known as 'Heavenly Counselors' -Seraphim, Cherubim and Thrones. Seraphim: These angels are dedicated to adoring God and singing, "Holy, Holy, Holy" forever. Cherubim: The title means 'fullness of wisdom.' They guard the Tree of Life in the Garden of Eden. They have the four symbols of the Gospel authors - ox, lion, eagle, and man. Thrones: The angels are living symbols of God's justice and authority. They have as their symbol the throne. They represent the humility of God. Little known fact: Humans have an angel assigned to them at conception – so all humans have access to their Guardian Angel.
