Dear parishioners and guests,

In a homily in December of 2005, Pope Benedict XVI said, "The first word on which I would like to meditate with you is the Angel's greeting to Mary. In the translation

the Angel says: 'Hail, Mary.' But the Greek word, 'Kaire,' means in itself 'be glad' or 'rejoice.' . . .

"This is the first word that resounds in the New Testament as such, because the Angel's announcement to Zechariah of the birth of John the Baptist is the word that still rings out on the threshold between the two Testaments. It is only with this dialogue, which the Angel Gabriel has with Mary, that the New Testament really begins.

"We can therefore say that the first word of the New Testament is an invitation to joy: 'rejoice, be glad!' The New Testament is truly 'Gospel,' the 'Good News' that brings us joy. God is not remote from us, unknown, enigmatic, or perhaps dangerous. God is close to us, so close that He makes Himself a child and we can informally address this God."

Gaudete Sunday, this Third Sunday of Advent, with its joyful Scripture selections, rose-colored vestments, and pink candle on the wreath, directs us insistently to the spirit of joy that should fill this holy season. Advent draws us into prayer and penance, but all in *joyful* anticipation of the coming of the Lord.

What part of your life needs to be touched by joy today? What are the burdens you have been carrying for a long time – burdens that tend to sap your energy or rob you of joy? Are there places of grief in your heart that are waiting for Jesus to come in and restore your peace and joy? Is there an old grudge that stands in the way of your being happy? Are you too riddled with fear, worry, or anxiety to feel any joy in your relationship with God or others? Do you find that anger gets in the way of the joy that ought to characterize your Christian life?

Again, the voice of the Church rings out: "Come, Lord Jesus!" Now is a great time to invite Jesus *directly* into these places that need transformation in joy. The grace of Advent helps us to open our hearts to receive all that God desires to give us. As Pope Benedict pointed out, the Gospel invites us, from the very beginning, to rejoice! So, let's live the rest of this Advent season in the spirit of joyful anticipation, and open our hearts for the imminent coming of the Lord!

on the provided sheets in the gathering area, and their names will be in the December 28 bulletin as an insert.




