Merry Christmas and happy new year! These are rich days in the life of the Church, as we complete our Advent journey and celebrate a good number of important

feasts over the course of the next couple of weeks. We have Christmas Day, the Feast of St. Stephen, the Feast of St. John (the Apostle and Evangelist), the Feast of the Holy Innocents (babies and children who died in Herod's pursuit of Jesus), the Feast of the Holy Family, the Solemnity of Mary, a handful of other Saints, and the Solemnity of the Epiphany. That's a lot of celebrating packed into a two-week period!

If you have travel plans during these holy days, I hope and pray that you arrive at your destination and return home safely.

Whether you are traveling or staying at home, I encourage you to be deliberate about your spiritual observance of the season. During the Christmas season, do something special for the Lord that you might not do at other times of the year. Express your love for Jesus and your gratitude for His birth in a meaningful way.

Is there some way you could set aside a little time, this Christmas, for God's glory? For example, is there some spiritual reading you could do? Or can you think of someone you could help in some way? Perhaps you could commit to learning each day about the feasts that are being celebrated (learning about the Saints' lives, etc.).

The end of the calendar year is always a great time to look back and thank God for everything He has done for us. What if everyone spent even half an hour, between now and January 1, making a list of the blessings they received in 2023? Surely if we all sat down to do that, we would find 30 minutes to be hardly enough time.

This season is also a great time, as the days are as short as can be (though beginning to lengthen, thankfully!), to take some quiet, meditative time to envision the coming year. No one knows what the future holds, but we can certainly talk to the Lord about our hopes and anxieties, and ask Him for the graces we need to grow in His friendship over the course of the next twelve months.

Whatever you decide to do for your spiritual life this Christmas – whatever gift you decide to give to Jesus – may the joy of the season fill your heart and may the celebration of the birth of the Lord give you new hope and strengthen your resolve to live each day through, with, and in Him.

We are taking a hiatus from Mystery of Faith during December and will resume Mystery of Faith on Tuesday, January 9th.


