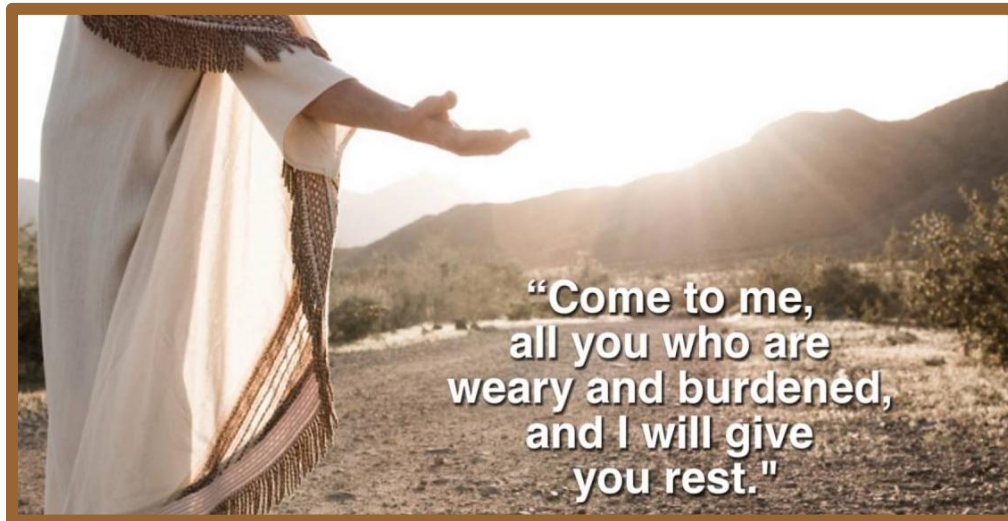

Mystery of Faith (Adult faith formation)

We are reviewing a series from Ascension Press on the life of Mary from a biblical perspective. In this session we will consider why Mary goes “with haste” to visit Elizabeth and the significance of Elizabeth’s greeting to Mary: “Blessed ... among women” and “mother of my Lord”—honorable titles that had not been given to anyone in Israel for centuries. Next, we will look at Mary’s response of praise in a prayer known as the Magnificat (verses 46-55). And finally, we will consider how Luke narrates Mary’s visit to Elizabeth in ways that recall a famous journey made by the Ark of the Covenant—the sacred vessel over which God’s holy presence dwelt in the Old Testament. Why does the Bible associate Mary with the Ark of the Covenant and what does this tell us about her?

St Mary of the Rosary concluded another wonderful Vacation Bible School last week as their program continues to grow! There were more than 38 young campers, 8 teen assistants, and 13 adult leaders participating in a five-day long pilgrimage through the rainforest to learn that God is our creator, knows everything, is our safe place, is love, and is forever. They were once again blessed to have seminarian Mitch Carey helping lead them through this special and prayer-filled week for a third year with even more help from seminarians James Vair and Michael Dumais. VBS has essentially turned into a Stevens County kids Catholic retreat with several families from Chewelah, Colville and Kettle Falls parishes in attendance. This year was also the first year with a completely independent preschool program with Director Amy Nixon leading 13 kids ages 3-5 in fun games, activities, and crafts exploring the nature of God at their level throughout the week.

Kellie Trudeau is the Director for the elementary program, which divides kids in first through fifth grade into families (crews) of mixed ages to experience and learn in different stations - from Bible Story Adventures in the Upper Room, to science experiments in the parish hall, to fun games in the field and of course snack time. The closing experiences for each day were the most powerful as the seminarians facilitated guided eucharistic adoration Tuesday and Wednesday and an outside rosary procession on Thursday, culminating with a beautiful children's mass on Friday morning celebrated by Fr. Vincent.
