TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment is due in full at the time of arrangement, or three business days before the first scheduled viewing. Payments may be made via cash, cashier's check, credit card or insurance assignment.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff and Overhead.....\$1,795

Our fee for basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to: staff to respond to initial request for service, 24 hours a day; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; planning the funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of notice; coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies, and others as required.

Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as regulatory fees, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) Additional staff services required are detailed for each level of service.

Embalming.....\$650

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with public viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Washington State law requires that upon receipt of the remains, the funeral home must either embalm or refrigerate until final disposition. (RCW 18.39.215)

**NOTE – Additional fee(s)/requirement(s) may be incurred for decedents weighing over 270lbs. Embalming fee(s) up to 250lbs. are included in the above-listed charge. Decedents over 270lbs add \$100.00.*
