As summer is right around the corner many of us are planning trips. Whether they include planes, boats, or cars---most of us depend on a plan and someone not with us is aware of that plan. It's important and can be lifesaving to let someone know where we are going, when we are leaving, and when to expect us. The same is true for our mental wellness. It's important to have a safety plan. Who will you call when you are having a stressful situation, feeling anxious, depressed, or even thinking of self-harm? Make a plan now and put it somewhere you can easily access it (ie. photo on your phone). Include names and numbers of people you can call, safe activities you can do to take your mind away from your thoughts, and a safe place you can go to be around people (a park, shopping mall, coffee shop, etc). Having this plan BEFORE you have a crisis can be LIFESAVING.
