



A unique urban outreach ministry, part of Myers Park Presbyterian Church, is based in Charlotte, N.C. Over the past 23 years, more than 10,000 people from 270 churches in 19 states have served through CROSS Missions. The formula is simple. Combine worship, reflection and service. Serve others morning and afternoon. Reflect and celebrate with devotions and worship, morning and evening. Through Christ, however, the results are anything but simple. Youth are transformed, returning home ready to meet the needs of their communities.

Youth experience up to eight different ministries. Ministry sites include serving people who are hungry, homeless, elderly and disabled as well as children. There are opportunities for both direct service and building relationships.
