

Cheerleading Class Policies

TARDINESS

Students arriving more than **5 minutes after the start of class** will not be permitted to participate in class that day.

ABSENCES

Participants may be dropped from class if they have **more than one unexcused absence in a month**.

To notify CYC of your child's **absence or tardiness**, please visit www.communityyouthcenter.org, click on **Membership**, and select **Vacation/Absentee Form** to submit your notification.

ATTIRE

Recreational cheerleaders are required to follow the CYC Cheer attire guidelines:

- Wear a **black "CYC Cheer" shirt** and athletic shorts, skorts, or leggings. CYC Cheer shirts are available for purchase in the main office.
- All participants must wear **lightweight athletic shoes with flat, soft soles**. Cheer shoes may not be worn outside of the cheer room. If you need a shoe recommendation, please email Coach Windy.
- Hair must be **tied back in a ponytail or braids**. Hair may not be worn down during class.
- **No zippers, buttons, jeans, or jewelry** are permitted.

If your child does not have the correct attire, they will not be permitted to participate in class that day.

All participants must also adhere to the **CYC General Attire Guidelines**.
