Questions for Further Application of God's Word:

- 1. Read 1 John 3:19-24. How does a person reassure his/her heart before God (3:19)? Why does John say that God is greater than our hearts? Are there times when our hearts (and their fears, doubts, uncertainties, etc.) seem bigger than God?
- 2. How does a person's heart condemn them? Have you ever had an experience where your own heart condemned you about something? Was it true conviction or false guilt? How did you respond?
- 3. Are doubts inevitable for a Christian? What about despair? How about lack of assurance of salvation for a Christian? Give some practical ways that you battle these things in your life? What does 1 John say about this issue? What other Bible passages address assurance of salvation?
- 4. What is the Obedience Test from 1 John? What is the Doctrinal Test? What is the Brotherly Love Test? Did you pass these tests? What is the Holy Spirit test from 1 John 3:24? What evidence do you have in your life that the Holy Spirit abides in you?
- 5. Read John 15:1-17 and note the parallels with 1 John, especially 1 John 3:19-24. How is God abiding in you right now? In what ways are you abiding in him?

Advanced Question: How would you respond to a person who says, "1 John 3:22 says we can have anything we ask of God; therefore I'm praying for a new Mercedes?" How do we properly interpret this passage along with other similar parallel passages (e.g. Ps 37:4; Matt 7:7-8; John 14:13; 15:7; 16:23-24; 1 Jn 5:14; James 4:2-3, etc.)?
