Questions for further application of God's Word:

GO DEEPER

Read 2 Timothy 1:1-14. How does the tone of verses 1–5 change in verses 6–14? How are these two paragraphs logically connected?

In 2 Timothy 1:10 Paul says that Christ "abolished death." How did Christ do that? How did Christ bring "life and immortality to light through the gospel?" What is the gospel? What does life and immortality look like? Are all people saved? Are you saved? If so, how do you know you are saved? Do saved people die? Do unsaved people live forever?

GET PERSONAL

(1.6 7)

Assess your allegiance to Christ. Are you a fair-weather Christian? Or are you a "die in prison for Christ" Christian? How is allegiance to Christ strengthened? How do cowardice, hardships, self-reliance, forgetfulness, and shortsightedness quench one's passion for Christ?

Assess your allegiance to sound doctrine. What are those doctrinal commitments that you would die on a hill for? Which doctrines/convictions can we agree to disagree on?
